European Research Council (ERC) Starting Grants. Call Now Open. Thai Researchers Eligible

Are you a talented early-career scientist who has already produced excellent supervised work, is ready to work independently and shows potential to be a research leader? The ERC Starting Grant could be for you. **Researchers of any nationality, including Thai, with 2-7 years of experience since completion of PhD are eligible.** All fields of research are supported. **Starting Grants may be awarded up to THB 55 million for a period of 5 years. Deadline 25 October 2022.**

European Research Council (ERC) Synergy Grants. Thai Researchers Eligible. Deadline 8 November 2022

The Synergy Grants are designed to tackle truly bold scientific challenges **by funding groups of up to 4 excellent Principal Investigators (PIs)** who jointly address the frontier of knowledge with a ground-breaking research proposal. **Any field of research** is eligible. While research must be conducted by all PIs in a public or private research organisation (known as a Host Institution, HI) in one of the [EU Member States](#) or [Associated Countries](#) - **one Principal Investigator per Synergy Grant group can be hosted or engaged by an institution outside of the EU or Associated Countries, e.g. Thailand.**
